Modesty in Church Out of respect to our Lord, we beg all to appear in church modestly dressed. No shorts allowed. Ladies heads must be covered, no slacks or pants, low cut or sleeveless tops. Your cooperation is evidence of your love for our Lord in the Blessed Sacrament and respect for the House of God.

Communion Fast Holy Communion may be received only by Catholics believing themselves to be in the state of Sanctifying Grace, who are observing at least one hour fast prior to reception of the Sacrament. We are urged, however, to observe the fast from midnight, or, at least for three hours. While always welcome, non-Catholics and those who do not accept the traditional teachings of the Church in matters of faith and morals, are NOT to receive Communion at this Mass. To receive Holy Communion do so in silence- do not say Amen.

Confession Procedure Begin your confession with "BLESS me Father for I have sinned", when you have received your penance, immediately begin your Act of Contrition.

Mass Requests \$20 stipend per Mass, intention box located on the wall in the gift shop.

Chapel Etiquette Food, drink and matches are not allowed. Please use the butane lighters to light the votive candles. When the Blessed Sacrament is exposed, genuflect on both knees and bow. Otherwise, genuflect with the RIGHT knee touching the floor.

No unapproved literature may be left on the premises. It will be discarded.

Need something blessed? The first Sunday of each month after each Mass, which is today. The next blessing will be September 1st. Please be there to pick up your item, it will not be held.

Sacramental Planning OLHC's autumn First Communion Class will begin on Sunday, September 8, the feast of the Nativity of Our Blessed Mother. This class is geared for children of about 7 years or above, and of average intelligence. If you have a child who needs to make his First Communion, he will need a St. Joseph First Communion Catechism book and a pocket folder to hold notes and handouts, as well as a Baptismal Certificate. Classes start at 8:45AM and last about an hour. Parents are asked to be present on the first day with their children in order to meet our instructor, Mr. Hubbard. There will be a sign-up sheet in the gift shop on August 11. Keep in mind that a Confirmation Class is also in the planning. That said, if you are an adult and have yet to receive these important sacraments, you should make plans to do so; check with the instructors. St. Emigdius, (died 309) a convert renown for miracles during his lifetime, was sent as Bishop to Ascoli Piceno, Italy, where he was beheaded for his faith and is there interred. In 1703 a violent earthquake hit the region, but failed to affect Ascoli, a wonder attributed to the Saint's intercession against earthquakes. St. Emigdius was celebrated as co-patron of the Diocese of Monterey/Los Angeles as early as 1922 where his feast day was observed on August 9.
