<u>Modesty in Church</u> Out of respect to our Lord, we beg all to appear in church modestly dressed. No shorts allowed. Ladies heads must be covered, no slacks or pants, low cut or sleeveless tops. Your cooperation is evidence of your love for our Lord in the Blessed Sacrament and respect for the House of God.

Communion Fast Holy Communion may be received only by Catholics believing themselves to be in the state of Sanctifying Grace, who are observing at least one hour fast prior to reception of the Sacrament. We are urged, however, to observe the fast from midnight, or, at least for three hours. While always welcome, non-Catholics and those who do not accept the traditional teachings of the Church in matters of faith and morals, are NOT to receive Communion at this Mass. To receive Holy Communion do so in silence- do not say Amen.

Confession Procedure Begin your confession with "BLESS me Father for I have sinned", when you have received your penance, immediately begin your Act of Contrition.

<u>Mass Requests</u> \$20 stipend per Mass, intention box located on the wall in the gift shop.

<u>Chapel Etiquette</u> Food, drink and matches are not allowed. Please use the butane lighters to light the votive candles. When the Blessed Sacrament is exposed, genuflect on both knees and bow. Otherwise, genuflect with the RIGHT knee touching the floor.

<u>OLHC</u> is an independent Traditional Chapel. We maintain no association whatsoever with Kentucky Resistance.

No unapproved literature may be left on the premises. It will be discarded.

Need something blessed? The first Sunday of each month after each Mass, which is today. The next blessing will be March 2nd. Please be there to pick up your item, it will not be held.

The second of Archbishop Lefebvre's four bishops has died. We learn with deep sorrow that Bishop Richard Nelson Williamson has been called to God on Wednesday, January 29, 2025 at 11:23 pm. Following a cerebral hemorrhage, he was rushed to the hospital on the evening of January 24, after having received Extreme Unction. He was 84 years of age, having been born on March 8, 1940. Ordained to the priesthood by Archbishop Marcel Lefebvre on June 29, 1976, he taught at the seminary in Weissbad for a year, then at Econe for five years. After a year as vice rector at St. Thomas Aquinas Seminary in Ridgefield, CT, he then directed that seminary in the United States for twenty years, then the seminary in Argentina for another six, before his retirement to his native England. He was Consecrated bishop on June 30, 1988, and he also served as the Society's Second Assistant General between 1988 and 1994. (FSSPX NEWS) Bishop Williamson visited OLHC and Msgr. Perez some 7 or 8 years go. May he rest in peace.
